WHO IT'S FOR

This Award is aimed at researchers with between 8 and 14 years' post-doctoral experience, who are in a full-time post that is fully funded for the duration of the Award and have an excellent reputation in a cancer-relevant field.

WHAT IT COVERS

This Award provides support for 6 years of research, up to a value of £1.5 million. This can be used to fund the salaries of postdoctoral researchers, technical staff and PhD students, plus associated running expenses and equipment.

RESEARCH AREA

Applications can propose cancer-relevant research in any of the following areas:

- basic biology
- · preclinical studies
- biomarkers
- imaging
- radiotherapy
- engineering and physical sciences

DEADLINES

The first funding decisions will be made in April 2015.

- → Outline application: 2 September 2014
- → Full application: 1 December 2014

Subsequent applications will be considered twice each year – outline applications accepted in February and August.
