

## **Santander PGR Grants - Policy**

**November 2012**

BU is working closely with Santander, who are committed to [supporting higher education](#).

As such, Santander are offering 25 x £1000 grants for BU Postgraduate Researchers (PGRs) to travel to at least one university from either the [UK Santander Universities Network](#) or one of the [Overseas Santander Partner Universities](#) to undertake a specific piece of work and build or develop links with international researchers.

This call is open to applications from any BU PGR, irrespective of mode of study (full-time / part-time) or funding status (BU studentships / externally funded / self-funded). Awards made will cover only direct costs (travel; subsistence; training or development costs) and all applications will need to include a precise breakdown of costs.

Successful applicants will be expected to participate in general PR activities about their research. This may involve attending events and promoting the benefits of the funding. *\*Unsuccessful submissions from the last round of the Santander Scholarship funding (run by the Research & Knowledge Exchange Office (RKEO)) cannot be resubmitted to this round. Previous unsuccessful applicants can submit new projects/ideas to this round.*

To apply, complete the Santander Application Form 2012-13 and submit it by email to the Graduate School (email [graduateschool@bournemouth.ac.uk](mailto:graduateschool@bournemouth.ac.uk))

The closing date for applications is **Monday 14 January 2013**. Applicants will be informed of the decision by the Graduate School, normally within four weeks of the deadline and funds must be spent before 31 July 2013.
